TINY SCOUTS (AGES 6 WEEKS-15 MONTHS)

Our staff balances individual attention with group experiences to ensure that your baby is learning and experiencing new things while being loved and cared for in a safe environment. WANDERERS (15 MONTHS+)

Toddlers are naturally curious and eager little learners. Their brains are like sponges, absorbing all the knowledge they can. That is why each day our Wanderers Room is filled with new experiences and activities to help keep those developing brains active. Our teachers are knowledgeable about the ever-changing development of toddlers and can easily adapt programs and activities to each child's age and stage. EXPLORERS (OLDER TOTS/YOUNG TWO'S)

With so many physical, cognitive, and social milestones to achieve in such a short period of time, our curriculum encourages children to learn through exploration and experimentation. Our teachers create a supportive, loving environment that fosters autonomy and self-confidence in these newly-independent and increasingly-social students This classroom is structured to meet the needs of our older tots and young twos while providing the foundation to prepare our two-year-olds to enter our Pathfinders class the following school year.

ADVENTURERS (TWO AND A HALF BY 9/1)

Oh, the adventures we will have! Two-yearolds are striving for independence and looking to explore which is why the Adventurers Room uses learning activities disguised as FUN! Our learning experiences are designed to promote the blossoming independence of two-year-olds, to help develop their social skills, and to foster selfconfidence. This stage is filled with huge thinking and emotional changes that will help these little ones make sense of the world around them. Our teachers are there to support them, and you, every step of the way!

PATHFINDERS (THREE BY 9/1)

The days in our Pathfinders Room are more structured than in the younger classrooms. Our teachers offer a wide

variety of activities based on the children's developmental needs and interests all designed to help further social-emotional growth and development. Our experiences are theme-based, and the teachers provide plenty of materials for children to explore and learn while encouraging their natural curiosity. These self-directed experiences with small group activities give children the tools they need to grow and develop in a nurturing, safe surrounding.







PRE-K TRAILBLAZERS (FOUR BY 9/1)

Our Trailblazers Pre-K room is focused on school readiness. We focus on enhancing your child's confidence and independence by providing activities to help them become problem solvers and lifelong learners. Social skills are developed and nurtured as they learn to effectively communicate with peers in all types of situations. Our teachers are experienced at making sure that all children are actively engaged, and they are always willing to pose additional challenges to further develop brain connections.

For billing purposes, tuition is fixed based on the expected days of attendance. This allows the monthly payment to remain consistent throughout the school year. The amount of tuition owed will stay the same for all payments August-May. School breaks of 3 days or longer (Thanksgiving, Winter Break, and Spring Break) are not counted towards tuition charges, however, holidays such as Labor Day, MLK Day, etc. are counted when figuring attendance days.
